ACTION ALERT - If You Care About DD Services, Call Your Senator NOW

[SB355](#) calls for a constitutional amendment on the November 2014 ballot that, if approved by voters, would provide protection against future budget cuts for critical supports and services for people with developmental disabilities and other vulnerable populations.

**SB355 is on the calendar to be considered by the full Senate at
9:00 am today, May 1st.**

Contact your State Senator and Senate President John Alario, if you want to express your support for the protection of these services. **Communicate that you or your loved one rely on these services (or are waiting for them) and feel they should be a top priority and protected from future budget cuts. SB 355 would provide this protection.**
