

This document outlines revisions incorporated in the Louisiana Department of Education (LDE) FFY16 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) grant application as a result of stakeholder feedback.

Location of Revision	Revision	Reason for Revision
Section II 5-6	Assurance 23b changed from 23b.2 to 23b.1	LDE continues to coordinate with the National Instructional Materials Accessibility Center (NIMAC) for classroom instructional materials and individual assessment vendors for accommodated versions of state assessment materials. The Office of Special Education Programs confirmed that 23b.1 is an appropriate assurance selection for this structure.
Section IV-1	Item J changed from \$5,869,240 to \$4,089,640	Projected funds expanding the special education work force were redirected to item L and the Jobs for Americas Graduates AIM High project was moved to item Q
Section IV-2	Item L changed from \$0 to \$1,000,000	To clearly demonstrate funds would be available to support expanding the special education work force, funds were redirected to this item from item J (where the project was previously included)
Section IV-2	Item M changed from \$2,220,490 to \$2,450,090	LDE originally proposed funds for expanding the Team Intervening Early to Reach all Students (TIERS) program to traditional school districts. In response to stakeholder feedback this expansion was put on hold and proposed funds were redirected to the Jobs for Americas Graduate AIM High program in item Q; support for Opportunity Grants focused on building local capacity to support career preparation for students with disabilities was added to this item
Section IV-2	Item Q changed from \$647,742 to \$1,197,742	The Jobs for Americas Graduate AIM High program was moved to this item with increased funds to add additional sites.
Section V-1	SFY 2014 amount changed from \$395,254,970 to \$397,953,156 and SFY 2015 amount updated to reflect \$405,302,728	The incorrect dollar figure was entered for SFY 2014 and the dollar figure for SFY 2015 was not available at the time of the initial posting. Both were updated.
