Sample Letter

Dear Representative _____,

I fully support several proposed changes to the state's system responsible for serving people with developmental disabilities that are included in HB1. The consolidation of Northeast and Northwest Supports and Services Centers and the transition of individuals with low support needs in the remaining centers to community-based services are two provisions that reflect best practice. Downsizing of these supports and services centers will allow savings to be realized now and in years to come.

Re-investing the savings into community services to address the needs of the thousands of individuals on the waiting list for home and community based services is very important to me. I'm very encouraged that the Governor included funding for 150 additional New Opportunities Waiver (NOW) slots for people with developmental disabilities in the budget. These NOW slots will provide much needed services to people living in their own homes who have been waiting up to nine years for services.

This budget will put Louisiana on the right path of reform to provide services so people with developmental disabilities can enjoy a healthier, higher quality of life at less cost to the state. I urge you to support these essential reforms and prioritize community-based services.
