

ACTION ALERT - Contact House Members Regarding EarlySteps Family Cost Participation

Voice Your Opinion on EarlySteps Family Cost Participation

Members of the House will be hearing <u>HB 375</u> later this week. This bill will authorize the Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH) to implement Family Cost Participation in EarlySteps using a sliding fee scale. (Click <u>here</u> for the sliding scale that is being proposed by DHH.)

Help Writing Your Email

Begin by sharing your current situation: For example, "My child is currently receiving EarlySteps services" or "My child benefited from EarlySteps services." You can also include how receiving these services has been beneficial to your child and how the implementation of family cost participation would affect your child/family.

End by telling your legislator how he/she can help: "HB 375 includes Family Cost Participation for EarlySteps. Please do not implement Family Cost Participation."

Why confirm your action?

Background Information

In an effort to save the EarlySteps Program from elimination during last year's legislative session, DHH issued stricter eligibility requirements for the program, cutting about half of its participants. This year DHH has proposed family cost participation to reduce the amount of state general funds needed to keep the program in operation.

<u>HB 375</u> passed out of the House Health and Welfare Committee on last Thursday without objection. The bill must now go before the entire House for a vote. Members of the House need to hear from you about how family cost participation in EarlySteps will affect children with developmental delays and their families.
