

ACTION ALERT #14 - Contact Your Representative to Save Waiver and Other Healthcare Services



On Monday, May 9th, the Appropriations Committee drastically cut funding for waiver and other healthcare services when they passed HB1, the State Budget for Fiscal Year 2017. According to The Advocate, "Committee Chairman Cameron Henry said he thought Edwards' administration placed too much emphasis on funding health care at the expense of higher education, so his goal was to try to level the cuts out between the two."

If the massive cuts to the Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH) are not restored by the full House or the Senate, the Children's Choice, Supports, and Residential Options Waivers would be eliminated in addition to the loss of many other vital healthcare services. The full House will debate the budget on the House floor tomorrow, Thursday May 12th.
