

## ACTION ALERT #19 - Contact Your Representative to Support Disability Services

The Senate met today to consider the State FY17 Budget (HB1). Thanks to your persistent advocacy efforts, HB1 passed by a vote of 37 yeas and 2 nays with funding for the following services/programs:

- NOW, Children's Choice, Supports, and Residential Options Waivers
- Long Term Personal Care Services (LT-PCS)
- Pediatric Day Health Care Program
- Human Services Districts/Authorities (Funding restored to the level originally proposed in the Executive Budget. However, the Districts/Authorities are still underfunded.)

The current version of HB1 still includes:

- \$170,000 cut to Families Helping Families Centers
- No funding to pay overtime for Direct Support Professionals
- No funding to fill vacant waiver slots for those on the waiting list

The budget now returns to the House for review where Representatives can concur with or reject the Senate's amendments.

Contact your personal State Representative to let them know how you feel about the current version of the proposed budget and the remaining unmet needs that must be addressed in the Special Session.

- Ask them to keep funding in the budget for ALL waivers and other disability services.
- Tell them there are still many remaining unmet needs of people with developmental disabilities that can only be addressed if the Legislature raises additional revenue in the upcoming Special Session.
