- Restraint and Seclusion and the establishment of the Advisory Council on Student Behavior and Discipline required by [Act 522 \(SB317\) of 2016](#)
- Opportunities for certain previous students with disabilities to ask for a high school diploma and schools not asking for medical information before a student is enrolled ([Act 303 \(SB 335\) of 2016](#))
- Communication plans in IEPs ([Act 250 of 2015](#)).
- Alignment process for English Language learners and students with significant cognitive disabilities
- Special education teacher certification
