Update/Progress on Agency Initiatives

New Opportunities Waiver (NOW)

Opportunities Allocated	8,832
Recipients Linked and Certified	8,481 as of 03/26/14

Children's Choice Waiver

Opportunities Allocated	1,475 (including 425 opportunities reserved for children who meet state-funded family support priority level 1 or 2)
Recipients Linked and Certified	1,142 (includes 372 opportunities filled by children who meet the above stated priority group) as of 03/26/14.

BHSF and OCDD are in the process of working with CMS to complete the renewal of the Children's Choice Waiver. The waiver was set to expire on February 20, 2014, approval was granted by CMS on February 7, 2014 to extend the renewal through May 20, 2014. The State has submitted a second request to CMS on March 6, 2014 to extend the renewal through June 30, 2014. This extension will allow us to align the waiver year with the State fiscal year. The renewal is anticipated to be approved effective July 1, 2014.

Supports Waiver

Opportunities Allocated	2,050
Recipients Linked and Certified	1,585 as of 03/26/14

 BHSF and OCDD are in the process of working with CMS to complete the renewal requirements for the Supports Waiver, which is set to expire on June 30, 2014. The renewal application was submitted to CMS on March 7, 2014 and is anticipated to be approved effective July 1, 2014.

Residential Options Waiver (ROW)

Opportunities Allocated	210
Recipients Linked and Certified	31 as of 03/26/14

- BHSF and OCDD received approval from CMS to renew the ROW for a five year period effective July 1, 2013.
- An amendment to the ROW was submitted to CMS by BHSF/OCDD on March 12, 2014. The purpose of the amendment is to propose to add Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) services to ROW. This amendment is pending CMS approval.

Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) Waiver

Community Choice Waiver

• BHSF and OAAS are in the process of working with CMS to complete the renewal of the Community Choices Waiver to be effective July 1, 2014.

Permanent Supportive Housing Services

 The amendment to add Permanent Supportive Housing services to the New Opportunities Waiver (NOW), Children's Choice Waiver, Supports Waiver, and Community Choices Waiver has been approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and has been implemented in the above referenced waivers.

Money Follows the Person

 Since fall 2009, approximately 805 individuals have transitioned through the MFP program from qualified institutions (hospitals, nursing facilities, and supports and services centers); Year-to-date, 313 individuals have transitioned.

Self-Direction

 There are currently 380 individuals participating in the self-direction option, as of March 26, 2014. The state has begun the RFP Process for the selfdirection, fiscal agent. The Acumen Fiscal Agent Contract for selfdirection is due to expire July 31, 2014.
