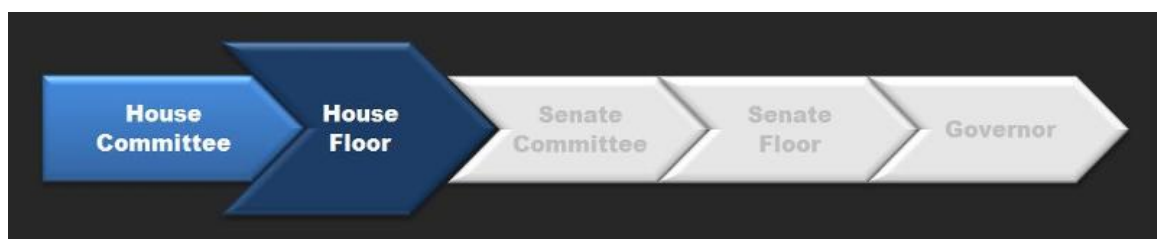

ACTION ALERT - Contact Your Representative to exempt Self-Direction from Medication Administration Requirements



[HB 185](#) by Rep. Kenny Havard would exempt Direct Support Professionals (DSP) working for waiver recipients in self-direction from the rigorous training currently required of all DSPs to administer any medication and perform non-complex medical tasks. HB 185 will be voted on by the **Whole House** on Tuesday, March 18th.

If this issue is important to you, call/email your Representative. Communicate the importance of EXEMPTING self-direction from medication administration training requirements.

Background Information

In December 2013, the requirements for a direct support professional (DSP) to administer medication and perform non-complex medical tasks changed. The new regulations require the provision of "nurse authorization" accompanied by 16 hours of

training. Additionally, the DSP must receive person-specific training for individuals for whom the nurse has authorized certain non-complex tasks. The nurse authorizing the tasks must document in writing that the trained DSP has demonstrated competency as provided in the rule.

Waiver recipients using self- direction currently fall under these new rules.
