#### **Update/progress on agency initiatives**

The Governor's Advisory Council on Disability Affairs met in Baton Rouge on December 3, 2014. The Council gave feedback on presentations on Managed Long-Term Supports and Services (The Office of Aging and Adult Services) and on Accessible Design Standards (The Office of the State Fire Marshall). The first part of our agenda was a continuation from our previous meeting on Managed Long-Term Supports and Services, where the council gave feedback on a presentation by the Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities. The Office of Behavioral Health has offered to join our next MLTSS discussion. Resources from the council's meetings can be found on GODA's website. The next Advisory Council meeting is scheduled for March 4, 2015.

The next Statewide Independent Living Council (SILC) meeting is Thursday, January 15, 2015 at the Claiborne Building in Baton Rouge. The Council will be discussing the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) and the direct impact of new federal regulations on the Centers for Independent Living and the SILC; including but not limited to the new federal structure and federal reporting.
