

## Action Alert #24 Update - Call Senators Cassidy and Kennedy to Save Medicaid and Waiver Services Today

June 26, 2017

The U.S. Senate plans to vote on its healthcare bill to replace the Affordable Care Act as early as **this Thursday, June 29th.** If passed, it will make **devastating cuts to the Medicaid program**, which includes home and community based waivers, EPSDT, personal care services, ABA, other long term support services, and basic healthcare for people with disabilities and other vulnerable populations in Louisiana.

# Call Senators Bill Cassidy and John Kennedy TODAY, TOMORROW and WEDNESDAY. (Yesterday Senator Cassidy said on TV he was undecided on the Senate's bill.)

Tell the receptionist you want to leave a message regarding the Senate health care bill. Let them know why Medicaid is important to you and that **NO cuts and NO caps to the Medicaid program are acceptable.**
