Two bills dealing with issues important to LaTEACH members passed the Senate Education Committee yesterday.

[SB317](#) by Sen. Donahue (Restraint/Seclusion Bill) seeks to establish reporting requirements on restraints and seclusion practices and to establish an Advisory Council on Student Behavior and Discipline.

- Thanks to the four parents who testified how restraints and seclusion practices impact their children

[SB310](#) by Sen. Claitor (Special Education Bill) would require BESE to report statistics about students with disabilities in school systems.
