### Appropriations to Discuss LDH Budget for FY17 & FY18

December 3, 2016

Answers for how or whether revenue shortfalls may reduce home and community-based services for people with developmental disabilities in Louisiana are expected to be revealed soon. Estimates indicate Louisiana's budget for Fiscal Year 2017 (FY17), ending June 30, 2017, will have \$315 million less than planned. Cuts to some programs and services seem inevitable with this level of budget shortfall. This Wednesday the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) is expected to share information with the House Appropriations Committee on how these revenue shortfalls will impact programs and services in FY17 and FY18.
