Looks like the Senate will vote on a Motion to Proceed with a healthcare bill on Tuesday. At this time, it's not clear if it will be on the repeal/replacement bill (Better Care Reconciliation Act) or the repeal without a replacement bill (Obamacare Repeal and Reconciliation Act). What is clear is that both healthcare proposals will do great harm to people with disabilities, their families, and the direct support professional workforce.

The Senate leadership's plan is to introduce amendments on one of the bills until they get to a proposal that can pass - a bill that will not have had any public review or hearings - or that you have had a chance to comment on. On such an important issue as YOUR healthcare and Medicaid home and community-based services, wouldn't you like that opportunity to comment? If the Motion to Proceed vote fails, the Senate cannot move forward tomorrow, and will have to take a step back and regroup. Contact Senators Cassidy and Kennedy today, tonight, and tomorrow to let them know how you feel about the Motion to Proceed on healthcare.
