The Council Seeks Ideas for FFY 2016 Activities

Each year the Council updates its Five-Year Plan and considers ideas for innovative and/or promising practices. The Council's [Five Year \(2012-2016\) State Plan](#) consists of five-year goals and objectives and single year activities for federal fiscal year (FFY) 2015. The Council is currently seeking ideas for FFY 2016 activities which would advance the Council's five-year goals and objectives from October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016.

Persons and organizations interested in offering an idea for the FFY 2016 Plan are encouraged to submit concept papers meeting the following criteria:

- Each submission must be limited to one page and include:
 - current plan goal and objective to be addressed,
 - plan for addressing the objective,
 - expected outcomes, and,
 - estimated funding (if applicable).

Concept Papers must be submitted by December 15, 2014 at 12:00 p.m. for consideration in the Council's FFY 2016 Plan. Submitted Concept Papers will be reviewed by the Council for possible inclusion in the Plan and/or dissemination of a Solicitation of Proposals.

There is no guarantee of funding to the submitter of a Concept Paper. Submissions not meeting the above criteria and deadline may not be considered for inclusion in the FFY 2016 Plan.
