## Share Your Opinion on Long Term Supports and Services

Louisiana is planning to move long term supports and services for seniors, people with adult-onset disabilities and people with developmental disabilities into managed care. This change will potentially affect you if you or a family member receive waiver services, are on the waiver waiting list, or reside in a community home, nursing home or other institutional setting.

Let your voice be heard on this issue. You can provide feedback to the Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH) on Managed Long Term Supports and Services during one of three webinars or in person at one of three public forums. The webinars and forums will begin with a brief presentation by DHH Secretary Kathy Kliebert, followed by 90 minutes of questions and an opportunity to provide input.
