The Council Seeks Ideas for FFY 2015 Activities

Each year the Council updates its Five Year Plan and considers ideas for innovative and/or promising practices. The Council's [Five Year \(2012-2016\) State Plan](#), consists of five-year Goals and Objectives and single year Activities for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2014. The Council is currently seeking ideas for FFY 2015 Activities which would advance the Council's 5-Year Goals and Objectives.

Persons interested in offering an idea for the Plan are encouraged to submit a one page concept paper that briefly explains the need to be addressed, the plan for addressing it, the expected outcomes, and, if applicable, estimated funding for the project. Concept Papers must be submitted by November 1, 2013, for consideration for the Council's FFY 2015 Plan. Submitted Concept Papers will be reviewed at the Council's January meeting for possible inclusion in the Plan and/or dissemination of a Solicitation of Proposals. There is no guarantee of funding to the submitter of a Concept Paper.
