

# Impact of Work on SSI

If you get a job making **\$8.25** per hour and you work **30** hours per week, earnings are **\$1,072** per month

Monthly Earned Income would be	\$1,072.00
Subtract two exclusions totaling (General disregard \$20, Earned Income Disregard \$65)	\$ 85.00
	<hr/>
	\$ 987.00

Disregard another 50% of earned income	x 50%
	<hr/>
Countable wages are:	\$ 493.50

If your SSI amount is:	\$ 733.00
You subtract your countable wages from that amount:	- 493.50
	<hr/>

Your SSI check would then be:	\$ 239.50
Plus....income from job:	\$1,072.00
	<hr/>

Your total monthly income is now:	\$1,311.50
-----------------------------------	------------

**That is \$578.50 more per month: \$6,942.00 per year!**
