



Medicaid Schedules Public Forums on Future of Managed Care

The Louisiana Department of Health is seeking public input as the State moves towards improving its Medicaid managed care program. It was announced that the Louisiana Department of Health's Secretary Dr. Rebekah Gee will be attending the March 15th forum in Lafayette.

The forums will allow participants to learn about, and provide input on, Medicaid's next Request for Proposals (RFP) for new Medicaid-managed care contracts.

Currently, the state has contracts with five managed care plans to provide specific Medicaid benefits and services to eligible children and adults in Louisiana.

The current Medicaid-managed care contracts will expire on December 31, 2019, and the new Medicaid managed care contracts formed through the RFP will be in place for January 1, 2020.
