



2017 Annual Report Available

Each year the Council publishes an Annual Report detailing its activities during the previous federal fiscal year. The [2017 Annual Report](#) is now available to view online. The report includes advocacy, capacity building and systems change activities that impacted policy and practice changes in 2017. The report features successful advocacy that resulted in appropriation of new funding for 627 waiver slots for those in emergent need, a requirement for the Human Services Districts/Authorities to allocate an amount equal to at least nine percent of its state funds to Flexible Family Fund and Individual and Family Support for people with developmental disabilities, increased representation of people with developmental disabilities and family members on the Special Education Advisory Panel and the Boards of the Human Services Districts/Authorities, and the prohibition of administration of corporal punishment to students with disabilities. Other highlights include workshops for families held across the state to encourage increased enrollment in the self-direction option in the waiver and the continuation of a technical assistance program for direct support providers.
