

<p><b>Goal 1: Reduce incidences of inappropriate discipline and illegal exclusions from public schools.</b></p>
<p><b>Description of Target Population:</b>          Students with disabilities in public elementary and secondary education who are inappropriately disciplined or illegally excluded in violation of procedural safeguards and/or substantive protections guaranteed under IDEA and Section 504.</p>
<p><b>Description of the problem to be addressed (include a discussion of existing barriers):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students with disabilities are often inappropriately disciplined or illegally excluded from public education without benefit of the procedural safeguards and/or substantive protections guaranteed under IDEA and Section 504.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Objectives (Measurable and Achievable within FY 2019):</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Provide representation to student(s) in public elementary and secondary education who are inappropriately disciplined or illegally excluded in violation of procedural safeguards and/or substantive protections guaranteed under IDEA and Section 504.</li> <li>2) Identify at least one (1) school district that arrests or disciplines students with disabilities in an inappropriate and/or disproportionate manner as compared to students without disabilities, and file at least one (1) complaint with appropriate state or federal agencies or courts.</li> <li>3) Participate in the Advisory Council on Student Behavior and Discipline.</li> <li>4) Participate in the Secure Care Task Force.</li> <li>5) Work with the Community Living Ombudsman Program to identify two (2) students in group homes being excluded from or inappropriately disciplined in public education.</li> </ol>
<p><b>f. Case Selection Criteria:</b>          Within the limits of its resources, the Advocacy Center will consider cases that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Are meritorious.</li> <li>• Address issues related to inappropriate discipline and illegal exclusions from elementary and secondary public and public charter schools.</li> <li>• May have a systemic impact.</li> <li>• Need Advocacy Center intervention to compel legal compliance.</li> </ul>
