The Louisiana Developmental Disabilities Council (LaDDC) and its grassroots advocacy network, LaCAN, are improving the way you will receive action alerts, info alerts, and the LaDDC News.

Voter Voice, our new system will automatically connect you with your personal legislator(s) and/or those legislators in your region based on your address. Trying to figure out which legislator to contact will be a thing of the past! What else can you expect from Voter Voice?

- The ability to "take action" directly from the alert by email, phone, or social media (Facebook & Twitter) whatever works best for YOU!
- Prefilled contact information to save time all you have to do is add your personal story and hit send
- Confirmation of your action automatically
- Information about issues affecting individuals with disabilities and their families

To continue receiving LaCAN Alerts and the LaDDC News, you MUST make sure your correct information is linked to Voter Voice. Setting up your account and contact information is easy:

- 1. You will receive a brief survey from the Council's email address info@laddc.org
- 2. Your contact information will be displayed in the survey
 - If your information is correct, just click "Yes"
 - If your information is incorrect, click "No" to edit and save your information
- 3. That's it!
