

OCDD Seeking Feedback in Regional Meetings

December 4, 2018

The Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities (OCDD) is hosting meetings across the state to highlight its work around Value-Based Payments (VBP) for Home and Community Based Waiver providers. During these sessions, OCDD will present an overview of work completed thus far during the CMS-sponsored Innovation Accelerator Project grant, and provide a look at the first draft of the VBP model. Under such a model, OCDD would set predetermined benchmarks for service providers who would receive supplemental payments based on high-quality performance. The model is intended to help improve the quality of home and community-based waiver services.

All provider agencies, staff of the Human Services Districts/Authorities, waiver recipients and their families, and advocates are welcome to attend a regional meeting and will be encouraged to provide feedback on the draft model.
