

February SNAP Food Benefits to be Issued Early

January 16, 2019

Due to the federal government's partial shutdown, most SNAP recipients in Louisiana will receive their February food benefits early - on or before January 20th. According to the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services, these are not extra benefits, but an advance of February benefits. Recipients are being advised to carefully budget to ensure their SNAP benefits last through the end of February.

Many people with disabilities and their families in Louisiana depend on SNAP benefits to supplement their food budget each month. If someone you know is a SNAP recipient, the Council encourages you to share this important information from the Department of Children & Family Services with them.
