

Stakeholder Input Sought on Community Choices Waiver

Community meetings are being held across the state by the Office of Aging and Adult Services to improve its Community Choices Waiver (CCW) program. The CCW provides services to seniors and people ages 21 and older with adult-onset disabilities in their own homes and communities as an alternative to nursing homes.

Unfortunately, there are more than 17,000 people waiting for these services. The Office of Aging and Adult Services wants to reduce the waiting list and is asking for stakeholders' thoughts on how they can reduce the list and develop strategies to swiftly help people receive the care they need.
