

Action Alert #12 Contact Senate Finance & Attend Public Testimony Day For the Funding of DD Services!

May 20, 2019



Let Senate Finance hear why funding DD services is important to you!

The state's budget bill (<u>HB105</u>) passed the House and is now being considered by the Senate Finance Committee. The committee plans to hear public testimony on HB105 on **Friday, May 24, 2019**. Several LaCAN members will represent our group by testifying before the committee, but it is important for LaCAN to fill the room with yellow shirts to show support for DD services!

The House added provisions that tied the hands of the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), while also adding line-item obligations without additional funding. LDH has testified before Senate Finance that HB105, in its current form, **is \$44 million in state general funds short of what is needed to:**

- Fund the rate restoration;
- Implement TEFRA; and
- Maintain current services.

If Senate Finance does not provide additional funding to LDH and remove the restriction related to the Public Private Partnerships in HB105, LDH officials testified that cuts may have to be made to current services for people with developmental disabilities and/or TEFRA will not be funded.

Two issues important to the disability community were also left out of the House's version of HB105:

- Additional funding for the State Personal Assistance Services (SPAS) program to serve all individuals on the waiting list; and
- Additional funding for the two Human Services Districts/Authorities with the lowest state funding per capita – Northwest LA & Florida Parishes.

How to Take Action

Contact the senator(s) from your area on the Senate Finance Committee by **Thursday, May 23rd**. Share your personal story and why the issues below are important to you, your family or someone you know:

- Rate restoration for waiver providers to 2008 levels;
- Implementation of the TEFRA Medicaid State Plan Option;
- NO cuts to current services for people with developmental disabilities;
- Serving people on the State Personal Assistance Services (SPAS) waiting list;
- Equitable funding for the two Human Services Districts/Authorities with the lowest state funding per capita – Northwest LA & Florida Parishes
