



Recruiting Strong Advocates for DD Council

The Louisiana Developmental Disabilities Council is currently recruiting applicants from Regions 1, 8, and 9 to fill two upcoming vacancies. Region 1 includes Orleans, St. Bernard, and Plaquemines parishes. Region 8 includes Caldwell, East Carroll, Franklin, Jackson, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union, and West Carroll parishes. Region 9 includes Livingston, St. Helena, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, and Washington parishes.

Applicants must be one of the following:

- An individual with a developmental disability;
- A parent or guardian of a child with a developmental disability; or
- The immediate relative or guardian of an adult with an intellectual developmental disability who cannot advocate for themselves.

The **deadline for applications** in order to be considered for this position is **November 14, 2019**.

Are you or someone you know interested in improving the system of supports for people with developmental disabilities and their families? Do you support the self-determination, independence, productivity and full inclusion of people with developmental disabilities in all facets of community life? If so, please consider submitting an application for membership on the La. Developmental Disabilities Council.

Council members are appointed by the Governor and generally serve four-year terms. Whenever there is a vacancy, a membership committee of the Council reviews all the applications received throughout the year and makes recommendations to the full Council for approval. Names are then submitted to the Governor for his consideration. The [Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act](#) includes criteria for all states to follow in selecting their DD Council's membership (including the [definition of developmental disabilities](#)) and the Louisiana Council takes care to ensure our membership is in compliance with our federal law.
