



Concepts Requested for Council Planning

January 31, 2020

The Louisiana Developmental Disabilities Council (Council) is accepting concepts (or ideas) to guide the development of its Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2021 Action Plan **AND** its next Five-Year Plan for FFY 2022 – 2026.

Concept Papers for the FFY 2021 Action Plan

These concepts should be aligned with the Goals of the current [Action Plan](#) and represent new activities to be implemented from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.

Concept Papers for the FFY 2022 – 2026 Five-Year Plan

Concepts for the five-year plan should represent broad strategies outlining innovative and/or promising practices aimed at improving services and advancing the lives of individuals with developmental disabilities and their families. Goals and objectives established by the Council for the next Five-Year Plan will be implemented from October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2026.

Concepts must be consistent with the Council's [mission, values, and vision](#). Submitted concept papers satisfying the following criteria will be reviewed by the Council's Planning Ad-Hoc Committees for possible inclusion in each respective Plan. There is no guarantee of funding to the submitter of a concept paper. Concept papers will be received until **Friday, March 13, 2020**.

Each submission must:

- Include your name and contact information
- State which Plan (FFY 2021 or FFY 2022-2026) you are addressing
- Use formatting of 12-point Arial font, double line spacing, 1-inch margins,
- Be limited to one (1) page,
- State an idea/issue to be addressed,
- Include a strategy for how to address the idea/issue,
- List expected outcomes, and
- Provide estimated costs to implement the idea/concept (if applicable).
