The Council is writing you to request that a formal investigative inquiry be opened and the following matters/issues be looked at promptly:

- The recording of a spring Partners in Policymaking meeting between several members of the class and the senior staff of the Council.
 - The creation of and subsequent existence of a transcript from that recorded meeting.
 - Who exactly advised the staff to record this meeting, what was that person's exact advice to the staff and was the advice verbal or written?
 - Who has the recording now as well as the transcript of that recorded conversation?
 - Was this lawfully and ethically done?
- The high turnover rate of staff within our office in the past three years as well as the recent resignations of the longtime Partners Program Coordinator and statewide LaCAN leader.
 - Were all regulations and law properly followed with these employees and any grievances they may have had?
- Were all public statements by the staff related to these issues mentioned consistent with all department policies and laws that our staff are required to follow ethically and lawfully?
- Has the Council been compliant with laws and policies in making recommendations and appointments to the Council?
