In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) granted OCDD a number of <u>exceptions for home and community-based waivers</u> to help ensure the health and safety of individuals with developmental disabilities. These exceptions are expected to end on January 1, 2021.
