House Appropriations to Vote on Budget Monday, May 3rd. Let Them Know the Importance of Disability Funding!

April 28, 2021



Monday, May 3rd House Appropriations meets at 9:00 AM to vote on the budget bill ([HB1](#)).

Unfortunately, the main budget bill still *does not* include the following items:

1. [Additional funding for the Families Helping Families \(FHF\) Regional Resource Centers](#)
2. [Funding to increase home and community-based service rates for those services provided by Direct Support Workers \(DSW\) and a minimum starting pay requirement of at least \\$8.65 per hour for DSWs](#)

Hundreds of advocates reached out to committee members over the past week to share why funding home- and community-based services and resources for individuals with developmental disabilities is important. With the budget coming before the committee again, it's important that you continue to let your voice be heard!

If these issues are important to you or someone you know, there is still time to take action!

How to Take Action

Share your personal story and explain how the issues above would affect you, your family or someone you know.

1. **Email or call** the Chair and members of the House Appropriations Committee (even if you have contacted them already) before the meeting on Monday, May 3rd. Find your member of the House Appropriations Committee at the end of this alert.
2. **Email** h-app@legis.la.gov your public comments about the budget no later than Friday, April 30th, by 11:59 AM for your comments to be included in the meeting record.
 - With your comments, please include your name, address, phone number, email address, and bill number (HB1).
