

# Action Alert #12 Let House Education Know the Importance of Requiring Cameras in Special Education Classrooms!

May 21, 2021



<u>SB86</u> by Senator Foil successfully made its way through the Senate. Now it heads to House Education for discussion!

Tuesday, May 25<sup>th</sup> (TENTATIVE)

House Education meets at 9 AM in Room 1 to discuss <u>SB86</u> which would require cameras be installed in self-contained special education classrooms upon request. *It is possible SB86 will be heard on Wednesday, May 26th, at 9 AM if the committee is unable to hear all scheduled bills on Tuesday.* 

Students with disabilities, particularly students who are non-verbal, are at greater risk of abuse and do not have the communication skills to self-report this abuse. Parents want peace of mind that their children are treated with dignity and care behind closed doors of special education classrooms. Video and audio surveillance increases student safety, protects educators from false accusations, and promotes improved training to address student challenging behavior.

If <u>requiring cameras in special education classrooms upon request</u> is important to you or someone you know, **NOW** is the time to take action!

#### **How to Take Action**

Share your personal story and explain how cameras in special education classrooms would affect you, your family or someone you know.

  - With your comments, please ensure to include your name, address, phone number, email address, and bill number (SB86).
