



## Legislators Want Your Opinion: Finding Children with Disabilities in Emergencies

During the 2021 Legislative Session, the legislature passed [HCR45](#) which asks the Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities (OCDD) to conduct a study to determine the feasibility and desirability of implementing a tracking system for children with disabilities who may wander.
