# Louisiana Rehabilitation Services (LRS) LRS Director's Quarterly Report December 2021

#### **PROGRAM SERVICES**

## **Pre-Employment Transition Services**

Louisiana Rehabilitation Services (LRS) provides Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) to students with disabilities between the ages of 16 and 21. Pre-ETS include Job Exploration Counseling, Work-Based Learning Experiences, Counseling on Post-Secondary Opportunities, Workplace Readiness Training and Training on Self Advocacy. LRS is currently serving approximately 2,821 students statewide.

LRS currently has 13 Third Party Cooperative Arrangements (TPCA's) with local education providers to provide Pre-ETS and is continuing to pursue additional TPCA's with other local school districts.

LRS's goal is to spend approximately \$10.6 million on Pre-ETS activities this state fiscal year.

## **Louisiana Rehabilitation Council (LRC)**

The next LRC meeting is scheduled for Thursday, January 27, 2022. The meeting will be held via ZOOM due to the recent increase in COVID-19 cases. Meeting information will be posted to the Boards and Commissions' website. We are currently seeking to fill four vacant positions on the LRC. Vacant positions include: a representative of individuals with disabilities who have difficulty representing themselves, a representative of Business, Industry, and Labor, the Director of a Federal Section 121 Project, and an advocate for individuals with disabilities.

## Rehabilitation Employment Development Specialist (REDS)

LRS has retained or hired a Rehabilitation Employment Development Specialist (REDS) in seven of the eight regions. Alexandria has recently hired a qualified candidate to serve their region in this capacity. We are still seeking applicants in the Houma Region. We will continue to post the Houma position on the Civil Service website and seek qualified applicants interested in working with people with disabilities.
