Due to technical issues with Zoom Video Conference, Chairman Bristo called the meeting to order at 9:24AM. A quorum was established. An overview was given of the mandate and funding restrictions for plan development. Mrs. Deaville also provided feedback from the Administration for Community Living (ACL) on the Council's Five-Year Action Plan (2022-2026). The Committee developed activities to recommend to the full Council for inclusion in its federal fiscal year (FFY) 2023 action plan. The committee also chose a new Targeted Disparity for the Five-Year Action Plan based on feedback from ACL.

The meeting was originally adjourned by unanimous consent at 4:10PM, but a motion to the full Council to accept the committee's proposed action plan was not taken. Members reconvened at 5:00PM to pass the motion but also made one change to funding levels. Christi Gonzales and Jill Hano were not present.
