Motions from Education and Employment Committee and forwarded to Full Council for approval: Motion #1: Motion that the Developmental Disabilities Council pursues an opinion from the Attorney General on open meetings law re: Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance to ensure all public meetings offer every available accommodation for individuals with disabilities to participate. Passed with no objections or abstentions.

**Failed**. Motion by Kim Basile, seconded by Nicole Banks. Motion for the Louisiana Developmental Disabilities Council put out a Request for Information (RFI) for the LaCAN and Partners in Policymaking Contracts. Motion failed by a roll call vote; 10 Nays, 5 Yeas, 1 abstention.
