



## Public Comment Sought on Council's FFY 2023 Action Plan

May 9, 2022

During the April 2022 quarterly meeting, the Louisiana Developmental Disabilities Council (Council) adopted its [Federal Fiscal Year \(FFY\) 2023 Action Plan](#) which will begin on October 1, 2022. New initiatives in the Council's Action Plan include:

- Support and technical assistance for the Louisiana Youth Leadership Forum,
- Advocacy with the Louisiana Department of Education to provide appropriate, accessible sexual education to high school aged students with intellectual and developmental disabilities and
- Research and collaborate with the Louisiana Department of Health to address accessible, educational materials on Women's health topics.

The plan also includes funding to continue training and/or technical assistance initiatives in employment seminars, supported decision-making, first responder training, emergency preparedness and response, the Postsecondary Inclusive Education Alliance, and systems change advocacy.
