Voting System Commission Public Meeting Notice

June 16, 2022

Disability advocates have two opportunities to share their feedback with Louisiana's Voting System Commission on accessibility of the new voting machines being considered for use in Louisiana. The Voting System Commission, created by [Act 480 of 2021](#), is scheduled to meet later this month to evaluate and recommend a new voting system to replace the old machines Louisiana has used for nearly three decades.
