

# Action Alert #2 Taskforce on Remote Operations of Public Entities

March 9, 2023

**Thursday, March 16<sup>th</sup>:** The Taskforce on Remote Operations of Public Entities is scheduled to meet at 9:30 AM in Room F at the Louisiana State Capitol to consider recommendations for possible legislation which may allow public entities to hold meetings and conduct business remotely (i.e. by electronic means or virtually). Advocates are encouraged to take this opportunity to share their views about remote meeting opportunities with the taskforce and attend LaCAN's first Yellow Shirt Day of 2023!

## **How to Take Action**

Share with the committee your thoughts, opinions and ideas about Louisiana offering remote meeting opportunities and how you or your loved one would be impacted by allowing, or not allowing, virtual participation in public meetings.

### 1. Attend Yellow Shirt Day!

- WHEN: Thursday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, at 9:30 AM
- WHERE: Louisiana State Capitol Room F
- This is a chance for you to share your story in-person before committee. It's also important
  for LaCAN to fill the room with yellow shirts to show the importance of this issue! If you
  plan to attend, want to share your story before the committee, need a yellow shirt and/or
  want to find out about carpooling options, contact your LaCAN Leader.
- 2. **Email** <u>marinovichl@legis.la.gov</u> your public comments about remote operations of public entities:
  - Only statements emailed to the address above and received at least four hours before the start of the meeting (9:30 AM on March 16th) will be included in the meeting record.
  - With your comments, please ensure to include your name, address, phone number, email address and let them know you are writing about the taskforce's recommendations for remote operations of public entities.

## **Background Information**

During the 2022 legislative session, <u>Senate Resolution 147</u> by Sen. Sharon Hewitt created the Remote Operations of Public Entities Taskforce to study the possibility of allowing public entities to meet remotely or virtually. During the March 16<sup>th</sup> meeting, the taskforce is expected to develop its recommendations regarding remote operations and bring legislation during the 2023 session to address this issue. This is why it is so important for people with disabilities AND their caregivers reach out to the committee and Chairwoman so your recommendations can be considered!

Technology has come a long way since Louisiana's Open Meetings Law was enacted in 1976. By amending Open Meetings Law to allow for remote or virtual participation and representation in public meetings, we can make meetings more inclusive of all individuals, including individuals with disabilities and their caregivers, and more transparent.

By requiring in-person participation only during public meetings, we are discriminating against individuals with disabilities and their caregivers by creating barriers that prevent their full participation. We lose valuable insights and stakeholder feedback on important issues that directly impact their lives. They should be afforded the same opportunities individuals without disabilities have to participate in all public meetings, both as members of the general public and appointed members of the public board. In fact, the Americans with Disabilities Act or ADA requires all states and local bodies provide reasonable accommodations for meeting which includes virtual or remote participation.
