

Action Alert #6 House Appropriations to Discuss Higher Ed

April 11, 2023

On **Thursday, April 13th, at 9:00 AM**, the House Appropriations Committee will discuss Louisiana's Higher Education budget for Fiscal Year 2024 (FY24) which will begin July 1st (<u>Agenda</u>- Page 2).

Unfortunately, additional funding for the Postsecondary Inclusive Education Fund was not included in the FY24 proposed budget. The legislature's help is needed to appropriate \$3 million in one-time funds to the Postsecondary Inclusive Education Fund to help provide our students with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) the same opportunities that are available to students without disabilities.

Know the Facts

Postsecondary inclusive education programs are important to students with I/DD because it provides them with the full college experience in an inclusive setting while teaching them the skills they need to succeed in life and become independent. From the very beginning, they are taught life skills, how to be independent and get help growing their social and support network. These programs also help participants obtain and maintain competitive, integrated employment. In fact, 71% of graduates from these programs are employed compared to the national average of only 34%.

Act 682 of 2022 passed the legislature unanimously and created the Postsecondary Inclusive Education Fund. Included in the fund was \$1 million that current programs and those interested in starting a program could utilize to help with costs related to start-up and expansion. Currently, there are only six programs in our state, and most of the programs are in the south leaving north Louisiana students with I/DD very few opportunities for a postsecondary education. Fortunately, since the creation of this fund, 13 two and four year programs statewide have expressed interest in starting a new program. With the average start-up of a program costing about \$156,000, the \$1 million added to the fund last year won't last long.

This is why we need the legislature's help in appropriating additional funds into the Postsecondary Inclusive Education Fund. These are not recurring funds. Any money deposited into this fund is considered one-time dollars and can be used year after year.

Upcoming Legislative Visits

Individuals with disabilities, family members, and advocates are encouraged to take part in LaCAN's advocacy efforts by participating in upcoming legislative visits.
