

Action Alert #3 BESE to Discuss LDOE Dispute Resolution Process

December 5, 2023

The Louisiana Board of Elementary and Secondary Education's (BESE) Academic Goals and Instructional Improvement Committee meets next Tuesday, December 12th, and they need to hear from you!

In September, the Legislative Auditor's office released a <u>report</u> related to the Louisiana Department of Education's (LDOE) complaint and dispute resolution process regarding Students with Disabilities receiving Special Education Services. At the October 2023 BESE meeting, the Board, after hearing powerful testimony from parents and advocates, directed the LDOE to bring an updated report to the December 2023 Academic Goals and Instructional Improvement Committee. (Agenda & Supporting Documents)

BESE requested the report include:

- Information about implementing recommended changes in the Legislative Auditor's report (as well as the Council of Parent Attorneys and Advocates report) regarding dispute resolution,
- Special education infrastructure,
- Key performance indicators and
- A plan to make the Individualized Education Plan (IEP) process easier for parents to use.

The implementation plan and policy were recently discussed and endorsed by the Special Education Advisory Panel (SEAP) at their November 29th meeting. You can view the <u>plan and draft policy</u> shared at the SEAP meeting in addition to the <u>meeting minutes</u> if you would like additional information.

Do you feel LDOE's implementation plan and policy does enough to restore the Dispute Resolution process? Let committee members and your BESE members know what you think!
