

# Action Alert #7 House Appropriations to Discuss LDH Budget

March 8, 2024

Louisiana's Regular Legislative Session kicks off this coming Monday, and legislators are hitting the ground running! On Tuesday, March 12<sup>th</sup>, at 8:30 AM, the Louisiana Department of Health's (LDH) proposed budget for Fiscal Year 25 (beginning July 1) will be presented to House Appropriations. (<u>Agenda</u>). LaCAN and the Council will be advocating for the following issues to be funded this session:

- 1. <u>Recurring Funding for Families Helping Families Regional Resource Centers</u>
  - During the last three legislative sessions, an additional \$500,000 in state general fund (SGF) was added to the Council's budget specifically for FHF Centers. The Council's request to include this additional funding in its FY25 budget was denied leaving these Center's in an unfortunate situation. Total SGF needed is \$1,007,517. This would ensure a standstill budget for the Centers.
- 2. Eliminate the Flexible Family Fund Waitlist
  - The Flexible Family Fund program is administered through the local human services districts/authorities and provides families of children with the most severe intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) and/or behavioral health needs a monthly stipend to help cover the excessive costs associated with their care. In the link above, you will find the amount of SGF each district/authority needs to serve all eligible children on the FFF waitlist, which totals approximately \$9.4 million.
- 3. Increase the Waiver Rate for Night Services
  - Funding is needed to increase the rate for night services to match the current day rate within home- and community-based waivers for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Currently, the night rate is \$5 less than the day rate (\$13.52 vs \$18.52). This disparity is impacting the availability of Direct Support Workers willing to work nights leaving individuals and families in desperate situations. Approximately \$10.1 million in State General Fund is needed to fix this issue.

At this time, none of the funding listed above is included in the proposed LDH budget. If you feel any of these issues are important and should be considered in the budget, let the committee members know!

Share your personal story with the committee and explain how you or someone you know has been impacted by any of the issues above.
