

# Action Alert #8 Two Opportunities to Share Your Thoughts on the FY25 Budget

March 15, 2024

Next week, advocates have two opportunities to share their thoughts about the Louisiana Department of Health's (LDH) proposed budget (<u>HB1</u>) for Fiscal Year 25 (FY25) which begins July 1<sup>st</sup>:

- House Appropriations plans to hold Public Testimony on HB1 Wednesday, March 20<sup>th</sup>. (<u>Agenda</u>)
- Senate Finance will discuss LDH's budget the following day Thursday, March 21st. (Agenda)

The Council and LaCAN will be advocating for the following issues not included in the proposed budget:

#### 1. Recurring Funding for Families Helping Families Regional Resource Centers

 During the last three legislative sessions, an additional \$500,000 in state general fund (SGF) was added to the Council's budget specifically for FHF Centers. The Council's request to include this additional funding in its FY25 budget was denied leaving these Center's in an unfortunate situation. Total SGF needed is \$1,007,517. This would ensure a standstill budget for the Centers.

#### 2. Eliminate the Flexible Family Fund Waitlist

• The Flexible Family Fund program is administered through the local human services districts/authorities and provides families of children with the most severe intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) and/or behavioral health needs a monthly stipend to help cover the excessive costs associated with their care. In the link above, you will find the amount of SGF each district/authority needs to serve all eligible children on the FFF waitlist, which totals approximately \$9.4 million.

#### 3. Increase the Waiver Rate for Night Services

Funding is needed to increase the rate for night services to match the current day rate
within home- and community-based waivers for individuals with intellectual and
developmental disabilities. Currently, the night rate is \$5 less than the day rate (\$13.52
vs \$18.52). This disparity is impacting the availability of Direct Support Workers willing to
work nights leaving individuals and families in desperate situations. Approximately \$10.1
million in State General Fund is needed to fix this issue.

If you feel any of these issues are important and should be considered in the budget, let members of both committees know, and join us for Yellow Shirt Day!
