The Louisiana YLF is for 10th – 12th graders with disabilities. It will be held **June 20 – 23, 2024** at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette's campus. All speakers are peer mentors with disabilities. In addition to learning about advocacy and leadership, delegates will have the opportunity to make like-minded friends and build community.

Lodging, accommodations, and meals will be provided at no cost. We have a staff to camper ratio of 1:1 as well as two RNs who will be onsite 24/7 during the program.
