

OCDD and START hosting Self-Advocate Meeting

The Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities (OCDD) has contracted with the University of New Hampshire Institute on Disability and their systemic therapeutic assessment resources and treatment (START) team to study mental health crisis services for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) in Louisiana.

OCDD and START are inviting self-advocates/people with lived experience to participate in a conversation about what is needed to improve mental health crisis services. It is essential to have the input of those actually receiving services so OCDD and START can gain a better understanding of what is working well across systems and what may not be working well from an individual perspective.
