PROGRAM SERVICES

Pre-Employment Transition Services

Louisiana Rehabilitation Services (LRS) provides Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) to students with disabilities between the ages of 16 and 21 with an active Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or who meets the definition of a student with a disability as covered under Section 504 or who is a student who has a documented disability. Pre-ETS include Job Exploration Counseling, Work-Based Learning Experiences, Counseling on Post-Secondary Opportunities, Workplace Readiness Training and Training on Self Advocacy. LRS is currently providing services to approximately **3,840** students statewide.

LRS currently has 19 active Third Party Cooperative Arrangements (TPCA) with local or state education providers to provide Pre-ETS and is continuing to pursue additional TPCA's with local and state education providers.

ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

Louisiana Rehabilitation Council (LRC):

The next LRC quarterly meeting is scheduled for November 7, 2024, and will be conducted at the Hampton Inn & Suites, 11271 Reiger Rd., Baton Rouge, LA. Information for this meeting, and about the Council, can be found on the Boards & Commissions and LWC websites.

Benefits Planning:

Thirty (30) LRS participants have been directly assisted with their SSI and SSDI benefits planning since July 1, 2024, by the LRS in-house Community Partner Work Incentives Counselor. Lighthouse for the Blind and LSU Human Development Center also continue to provide Work Incentives Planning and Assistance.

DIF (Disability Innovation Fund) Projects:

Project STEMM-Up ended on May 31, 2024. The LRS contract with Michigan Rehabilitation Services (MRS) ended on September 30, 2024, signifying the official end of all programmatic and fiscal activities for Project STEMM-Up. Individuals who were participating in this project will continue to receive services through VR.

Statewide Trainings:

The Training unit has begun conducting a week-long training event in multiple regions throughout the State called "The VR Journey" discussing the vocational rehabilitation process from referral to closure, along with the different vocational rehabilitation services that are available to eligible participants. Dates have been scheduled from October through December 2024 in order for all LRS Counselors, District Supervisors, and some support staff to attend.
