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Legislative Session

The 2025 Legislative Session convened on Monday, April 14, 2025 and will adjourn on Thursday, June 12, 2025. The Governor's Office of Disability is monitoring all legislative activities, legislative instruments, and disability specific legislative priorities from the 2025 Regular Session.

The Governor's Office of Disability Affairs invites any all organizations and their representatives to meet with the Executive Director to discuss their legislative positions.

2025 Disability Awareness Day At The Capitol

On June 2, 2024, The Split Second Foundation and The Governor's Advisory Council on Disability Affairs will co-host the 2025 Disability Rights Day at the Capitol.

This event will enable disability based organizations to meet and interact with legislators, the Governor's Advisory Council on Disability Affairs, and state leaders during the 2025 Regular Session to emphasize the importance of their work in their communities.

There will be between 15-20 participating organizations at the Disability Awareness Day at the Capitol event. Participants will be allowed to set up a table in the Capitol Rotunda to share information about their organization to legislators and the public.

An itinerary and schedule of events will be made available by May 1, 2024.
