PROGRAM SERVICES

Pre-Employment Transition Services

Louisiana Rehabilitation Services (LRS) provides Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) to students with disabilities between the ages of 16 and 21 with an active Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or who meets the definition of a student with a disability as covered under Section 504 or who is a student who has a documented disability. Pre-ETS include Job Exploration Counseling, Work-Based Learning Experiences, Counseling on Post-Secondary Opportunities, Workplace Readiness Training and Training on Self Advocacy. LRS is currently providing services to approximately **4,065** students statewide.

LRS currently has 19 active Third Party Cooperative Arrangements (TPCA) with local or state education providers to provide Pre-ETS and is continuing to pursue additional TPCA's with local and state education providers.

ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

Louisiana Rehabilitation Council (LRC):

LRC Chairperson, Mrs. Lynn Stevens, unexpectedly passed away late November 2024. Benefits Planning:

Thirty-three (33) LRS participants have been referred for Work Incentives Planning this quarter and received assistance with their SSI and SSDI benefits from the LRS in-house Community Partner Work Incentives Counselor. Several of these referrals still need additional information from SSA, so their Work Incentives Planning services will continue through the next quarter.

Statewide Trainings:

The LRS Training unit concluded providing a series of week-long training sessions called "The VR Journey" for all LRS staff statewide. These sessions were conducted from September through December in Baton Rouge, Lafayette, and Shreveport, and discussed the entire vocational rehabilitation process from referral to closure.

LSU-S INAR Agreement:

The agreement between LRS and LSU-S Institute for Non-profit Administration and Research (INAR) was approved by all parties for activities to begin on the development of the 2025 LRS Comprehensive Statewide Needs Assessment. This report will help guide LRS to identify and implement appropriate goals and priorities for planning purposes.
