In total, we recognized 43 outstanding artists for the inclusive art contest and 13 individuals and organizations took home GOLD Awards.


State Capitol Construction Update

2026 Legislative Session Update

The Legislative session is set to convene at noon on Monday, March 9, 2026 - Final Adjournment no later than 6:00 pm on Monday, June 1, 2026. GODA will work with the Landry Administration, advocates, state agency partners, and nonprofit organizations to move the statewide disability community forward.

2026 Disability Awareness Day

Preliminary meetings are being held to plan the 2026 Disability Awareness Day at the capital. Last year's inaugural event saw 300 people with a disability, representatives from more than 20 statewide organizations, and dozens of legislators and stakeholders met to discuss topics and issues that matter to them as well as discussing potential legislative action.
